

Your tissue, your choice

- Guidance for those who have had a sample taken from biological material

What happens to your biological material?

If you have had samples taken, such as blood, tissue, or secretions, in connection with treatment in the healthcare system, the treatment facility may store your biological material in their biobank so that it can be used for future analyses related to your treatment or for research.

If you do nothing, the treatment facility will destroy or store the biological material safely.

Your rights

You have the right to decide that your biological material may not be used for research, but only for your own treatment. You can do this by registering in the National Database of Non-Consent to the Use of Tissue Samples for Scientific Purposes (Vævsanvendelsesregisteret).

Destruction of or information about your biological material

If you want information about your biological material or wish to have it destroyed, you should contact the place where the sample was taken. This will typically be at a hospital or with your general practitioner.

The Danish Health Data Authority does not have access to or information about biological material; we are solely responsible for the registration with the National Database of Non-Consent to the Use of Tissue Samples for Scientific Purposes (Vævsanvendelsesregisteret).

Your biological material, your choice

You can decide that your biological material may not be used for research and may only be used for your own treatment.

You can register via digital post using MitID on borger.dk here: [Registrering i Vævsanvendelsesregisteret](#), or you can alternatively complete and submit the form found on the next page. You also have the option to unregister from the register in the same way if you change your mind.

Your decision will be recorded in the National Database of Non-Consent to the Use of Tissue Samples for Scientific Purposes (Vævsanvendelsesregisteret) which all biobanks must consult before releasing biological material for research or any other purpose not related to your treatment.

Registration of a child over 15 years of age

Parents cannot, as a rule, register in the National Database of Non-Consent to the Use of Tissue Samples for Scientific Purposes (Vævsanvendelsesregisteret), on behalf of their child once the child is 15 years old. It is only the child who can make such a decision, and therefore the registration must be made by the child themselves, according to section 17, paragraph 3 of the Health Act.
